1st Saturday

14.00	Departure from Rome Fiumicino Airport, transit to Agnone with a stop on the way
17.30	Settle at accommodation
18.30	Meet for welcome drink and dinner

1st Sunday

Morning	Orientation/visit of the town + meet the teachers for assessments
Afternoon	Cooking and sharing lunch at a family agriturismo outside Agnone
Evening	Free time to explore the town and have dinner

Monday – Friday, both weeks

Mornings Italian lessons 10.00 – 13.30 with coffee break

Afternoons

- 1-2 hour sessions, in Italian, for visits /tours /talks: visiting a family small-holding – an artisan foundry or workshop – a hike in the hills - the traditions of Agnone – museo dei costumi - a historic site - tour of the centro storico - Agnone's artisans –making dinner together with our hosts....
- Private 1-2-1 conversation classes can be arranged with the teachers
- Homework and self study is an important part of the programme so there is always time allowed for this during the day

Evening

- Group dinners, the majority with Italian hosts
- Attending current local events and festivals
- Visits outside of Agnone for tours and dinners are planned around local events and festivals

2nd Saturday

- Explore Agnone's local market and the town
- Visit to caseificio to see the pasta filata method of making cheese and hear about the transumanza
- A hike in the hills
